1. Introduction:

Development Impact Solutions (PVT) is implementing a project, “Linking Brick Kiln Women Workers with Formal Health Care System”, of Health & Nutrition Innovation Fund (HANIF), managed by Palladium and funded by the Department for International Development (DIFD). The aim of this initiative is to create awareness among brick kiln women workers regarding benefits of seeking formal medical services rather than relying on traditional healing techniques and approaching quacks. The project involves setting up Primary Health Care Satellite (PHCS) at four brick kiln clusters located in Rawalpindi and Lahore. The four PHCS will be established in collaboration with and under supervision of the Punjab Department of Health and the Brick Kiln Owners Association of Pakistan (BKOAP). The PHCS will both create health awareness among brick kiln women workers and also cater to their basic health care needs. Under this project the DIS intend to pre-qualify a vendor to supply medicine for PHCS in Islamabad Office up till September 2018.

2. Technical and Financial Proposal

- Antacids and other anti-ulcer,
- Anti-emetic drugs,
- Antispasmodic drugs, Laxatives,
- Antidiabetic,
- Ophthalmic preparation,

- Antidepressants/ Anxiolytics,
- Vitamins and minerals,
- Antidotes and other substances used in poisonings,
- Disinfectants,
- antiseptics and anti-infectives,
